# Guidelines:

- 1) Incentives apply for new construction, conversion from fossil fuel to electric or air conditioning to a heat pump, and upgrades of existing heat pumps to a new pump.
- 2) All air source heat pumps must be at least a 15 SEER, 12.5 EER and 8.5 HSPF or higher efficiency rating.
- 3) An AHRI or EnergyStar certificate is required for all heat pumps. If a certificate is not attached to the verification form the maximum incentive will be \$100.
- 4) All space heating and water heating equipment must be permanently installed and operating in a residential single-family dwelling.
- 5) Mobile homes meet the criteria for residential classification if designed for year round living, set on a permanent foundation, skirted, permanent utilities are installed and the towing provisions and running gear are removed.
- 6) A cabin must be heated during the winter months of October to May.
- 7) Duplexes or Condominiums must be separately metered to be eligible.
- 8) The installing dealer must complete startup testing, review potential issues with customer and complete the Air Source and Geothermal Heat Pump Application.
- 9) All incentives will be paid when the application form is received by Twin Valleys Public Power District.
- 10) When two or more heat pumps are installed in the same house, both or all are eligible for the full rebate amount.
- 11) Package Terminal Heat Pumps (PTHP's) are not eligible. Only split system heat pumps with a ducted supply and return system and the duct-less mini-splits are eligible.
- 12) Installation of the water heater must be new or a conversion from a fossil fuel and in connection with electric heating. The home needs to qualify for Twin Valleys Public Power District's all-electric rate.
- 13) A copy of the paid invoice must accompany the rebate request.
- 14) The desuperheater rebate and the resistance water heater rebate can both be received by the homeowner if both are installed.
