Guidelines

- 1. A \$1500 scholarship will be paid out after the 1st year and a \$1500 scholarship will be paid out after the 2nd year for a total of \$3000 provided a transcript is received from the school showing successful completion of each year before payment. Payment will be made directly to the student.

- 5. The Selection Committee will choose one student annually as the recipient of this scholarship.
